# SCHOOL RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. English is the official language of communication in classrooms and around the school except during Chichewa lessons. Failure to adhere to this will attract a punishment.
- 2. Lessons start at 7:30am to 12pm lunch break and 1:30pm in the afternoon to 3:30pm. All students are therefore expected to be in their respective classrooms by 7:00am and 1:25pm for the morning and afternoon sessions respectively. Expected time may change following special arrangements with teachers or the school. Students who are not punctual will not be allowed to attend classes

that day. The school conducts weekly assemblies every Monday at 7:10am and every student **MUST** attend.

- 3. In case of absenteeism, a notice from parents/guardian or doctor MUST be given to the form teacher or before the days they report back to school. If the period of absenteeism is more than two consecutive days, the student will only be allowed to attend classes after obtaining written permission from the Teacher on Duty, Deputy Principal or Principal.
- 4. Kingdom Builders Academy academic assessment comprises of 40% continuous assessment plus 60% end of term examinations. A student is required to get an aggregate of 40% to move to the next class. Any student who fails the third term examinations it's a **must** to repeat the same class. Any student who shall be found cheating in any examination here shall be penalized and be suspended from school for one week.
- Apart from teaching and learning, the school has programs like clubs and societies as well as
  extra-curricular activities. All students MUST patronize these programs. Failure to do so will
  attract disciplinary measures.
- 6. The school selects prefects and monitors who MUST be always obeyed. The school will discipline anyone disobeying their reasonable order. Students MUST be always obedient to leaders and members of staff at any level. The school will discipline anyone disobeying their reasonable order.
- 7. Students **MUST** at all time show respect to teachers, administrative and support staff as well as visitors. Male staff members must be addressed as Sir while female staff members must be addressed as madam.
- 8. All students at KBA are required to wear a complete AND appropriate school uniform, everyday including leather black polished shoes, necktie, and socks. Our school uniform is **ONLY** supplied by our school only and students that buy from other suppliers will not be considered as having our uniform. Please note that students will not be permitted in class unless they are wearing a full school uniform. We also issue a school jersey to be worn during cold weather. We do not allow any other jersey a pat from school jersey.
- 9. Hair must be always clean and tidy. Female students should have their hair pulled back and off the face. Cut styles such as mohawk, afro, shaved styles and /or patterns shall not be allowed. The colour must be the student's own natural colour, no dye nor highlights are allowed. All students are prohibited from wearing adornments (Jewellery of any kind, Necklace, Bracelets, earrings, etc.) make up or sunglasses. Students must at all-time look neat and tidy. Wearing of School Uniform is compulsory on all days of the week except on specific occasion like casual days.
- 10. Visitors are not supposed to meet any student unless they seek permission from the principal/ form teacher. All messages must be channeled through them and depending on the nature of the message they shall decide to pass the message to the student or not. Parents or relatives visiting their wards must show respect to ALL members of staff by obeying and following any reasonable instructions given to them.
- 11. Scribbling on the walls, desks, benches, chairs, and any other action that will deform or damage school property is strictly prohibited. Those that are found doing this shall be asked to replace the damaged property.
- 12. Any form of misbehaviour (insults, bad manners, stealing, making noise) will be met with serious reprimand and may lead to expulsion or suspension.

- 13. Cellular phones and other electric gadgets (Bluetooth speakers, I pads, portable DVD players, MP3 Players, I pods, etc.) are not allowed. If found in possession, they will be confiscated and will never be redeemed.
- 14. Students are not allowed to bring to school any items, and publications which are not required for studies.
  - Absconding classes is prohibited and if found a disciplinary measure shall follow.
- 15. A student will not be permitted to attend any other function not related to school such as wedding, engagement (chinkhoswe), Sadaka etc, but may be allowed to attend funerals of a close relations.

# Offering quality education and excellent boarding facility

#### A: VISITING HOURS

Visiting hours are from 7:30AM to 12:15PM every first Saturday of the month

#### **B: WORSHIPPING**

The Academy shall permit boarders to go and worship according to their religion on the following days:

-Friday from 12pm to 2pm -Saturday from 9am to 12pm -Sunday from 9am to 12pm

#### C: BOARDING FEES

The Academy will allow two instalments with first Instalment on the day the learner arrives at school and Second Instalment at the end of the month unless otherwise.

#### **BOARDING RULES AND REGULATIONS**

- 1. Boarders are expected to arrive a day before school opens unless otherwise.
- 2. Boarders must bring their own beddings, a plate, spoon, a cup, reasonable quantity of clothes, a mosquito net, a pail and food items which KBA shall allow includes strictly, snacks, squash, roasted corn, ground nuts.
